Thoughts on the Scriptures

1Corinthians 13 (part 8)

Sometimes it is easier to say what something is not, than to describe what it is. Love might be one of those things. It might be easier to say what love is not rather than actually describe love. Paul in 1 Corinthians chapter 13 provides a detailed description of love. He paints a picture of what it is and what it is not. Love does not envy, we read in verse 4 of this chapter.

Envy is a feeling of discontented or resentful longing aroused by someone else's possessions (dictionary.com). Love however does not contain, is not motivated by and does not envy. One's love for another will mean they are not envious of that person because of their achievements, wealth or any other aspect of their life. Rather, a person will rejoice with the one they love over these things. An attitude of love rejoices with someone in their accomplishments rather than having an attitude of discontent because of what someone else has.

Envy is not just a feeling but it is an attitude that has disastrous consequences. Head the warning from the following passages:

Job 5:2 - *'For wrath kills a foolish man, and envy slays a simple one.'*

Proverbs 14:30 - *'A sound heart is life to the body, but envy is rottenness to the bones.'*

Envy is an attitude that is present in those who are unsaved but should not be present in the believer (Galatians 5:2), the Christian is to lay aside envy (1 Peter 2:1) and seek God alone. We were once envious (Titus 3:3) however because of God's saving grace we are now a new creation. May we as the church remember to be walking as the new man, not with envy but with love for one another.
